## Accommodations

## Transportation

### From the airport

### Car rental

For those travelling from outside the area, **renting a car is optional**. It's about a 15-20 minute walk to the farthest destination. We will coordinate your transportation to and from ride-a-longs/site visits. So, unless you want a car to tour Seattle in the evenings, you probably won't need one.

### Parking

If you opt to rent a car or you bring your own, the hotel charges for parking. The rate is \$16/day. Parking is at a premium in that area as the hotel is sandwiched by a community college and Seattle University, and two major hospitals. Pay lots are also located near the meeting venues.
